



# JCC Kids Connection Behavior Agreement

I agree to follow the rules and behavior guidelines of the JCC Kids Connection (KC) Program. Program rules include, but are not limited to the following:

1. I will be respectful of my fellow KC participants and all program staff. This means that I will speak to others in a respectful manner and tone of voice, I will follow directions and I will not cause or threaten physical harm towards others. I understand that disrespectful behaviors include, but are not limited to, hitting, punching, kicking, biting, spitting, swearing, lying and refusing to listen to the JCC staff.
2. I will be respectful of the JCC grounds and building, places we may visit and the belongings of others. This means that I will not litter, vandalize, steal or destroy items that do not belong to me. I will act in a behavior that will not give a negative image of the JCC.
3. I agree to follow all KC rules including those that are not listed on this behavior agreement.

**KC Student:** With a parent, I have read the JCC KC Behavior Agreement and I agree to follow the rules. I understand that not following these rules will result in consequences to my actions. In some cases, consequences may include not being allowed at KC for a period of time (1 day – the rest of the school year) or not being allowed to participate in certain activities (including KidFit, swimming, etc.).

**Parents:** By signing this document you are acknowledging that you have read and understand the rules listed above, that the consequences listed below may be imposed at any time, and that you will arrange for your child to be removed from KC if the JCC staff requests for you to do so.

**On or After the date listed with signature:**

**First Occurrence** – The first time an incident happens will result in a phone call home. A Senior Staff Member will explain to parents what happened and that such behavior is not acceptable. In the case where kicking, biting or other severe behavior occurs, the child may automatically be given one day suspension from the program, with no refund for that day.

**Second Occurrence** – The second time an incident occurs will result in a second phone call home from a Senior Staff Member, most likely the Director. At least one day suspension may be given, if not more (with no refund) and it will be explained to the parent that the next occurrence will result in the child’s expulsion without refund.

**Third Occurrence** – The third incident will result in immediate expulsion from KC without refund. The Kids Connection Program Manager, Ashley Gregory, will make final determination for expulsion.
