Position Summary:

As a member of the Simon Family JCC, the Summer Camp Counselor will be responsible for working with children between the ages of 2-15 years in a nurturing and safe day camp setting by providing high quality and engaging activities and programming to all participants.

Job Responsibilities:

- Supervise and monitor camp participants within assigned age group
- Plan and implement daily activities for campers of assigned age group
- Monitor attendance and safety of all camp participants of assigned age group and respond appropriately
- Develop positive nurturing relationships with participants
- Develop positive nurturing relationships with staff in assigned unit
- Integrate camp language into daily use
- Observe CILT interactions with campers and providing input on evaluation reports
- Maintain standards set forth by the Virginia Department of Social Services in all areas of programming and activities
- Provide a clean, safe and well-maintained environment for all participants
- Attend all scheduled camp meetings and participate in JCC programs as required
- Accept any other responsibilities assigned by Camp Leadership
- Promote the JCC mission and values in all actions

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Team player who is motivated, enthusiastic, and interacts well with children and adults
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Infant Child and Adult CPR/AED Certification (training will be provided)
